

Steps to Open a Statewide Mobile Food Booth

***** Preparing foods at home is PROHIBITED *****

1. Fixture requirements

1. Three compartment sink with drain boards or other acceptable methods
2. Hand wash sink (splash guards required if adjacent to other sinks)
3. Potable water tank
4. Waste retention tank which is 50% larger than potable tank.
5. Hot and cold water under pressure.
6. Toilet facilities to be conveniently located near area of operation.

2. Fee Schedule

1. Permit: \$160

3. Plan Review

1. Four (4) sets of plans
 - a. Floor plan
 - b. Plumbing riser diagram
 - c. Submitted by a licensed plumber.
2. Reviewed by Mercer County Health Dept, Environmental staff
3. Submitted to KY Division of Plumbing for approval
4. Submission and review fee: \$25

5. Location

1. Shall not operate for more than fourteen (14) consecutive days at one (1) location.
2. After the fourteen (14) consecutive days has expired, a mobile food unit shall not operate at the same location until a period of thirty (30) days has elapsed.
